

Book Reviews

Everyone can have a go at writing a book review! The rules are really very straightforward!

If you are in Early Years or Key Stage One, there is a space to write the name of the book and the author as well as your own name at the bottom. In between, there is a large space where you can draw a picture about the book and a couple of lines where you can write some information too! You can then hand it in to your teacher who will do two things:

- Say thank you very much and put it on display;
- Make a note of each review you complete.

Once you have completed ten reviews, you will get to choose a brand new book to keep!

In Key Stage Two, you still have the boxes to complete, naming the book, the author and, indeed, yourself! However, your task is to write a 'fifty word review' (don't worry, we won't be counting too strictly!!). You, like EYFS and KS1, can hand it into your teacher who will respond in exactly the same way!
