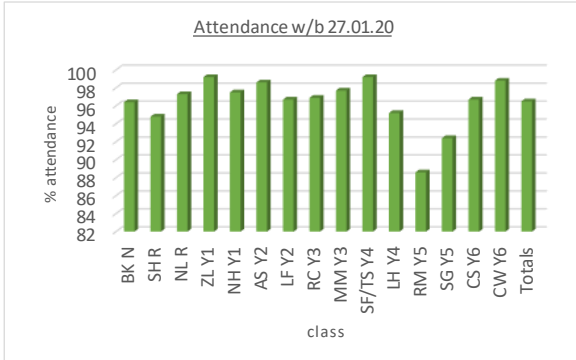
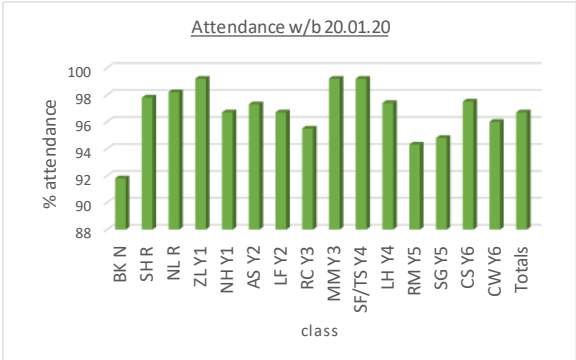
Discos
