Non Uniform Day

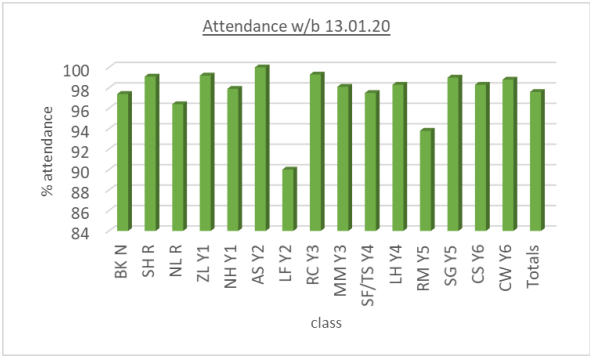
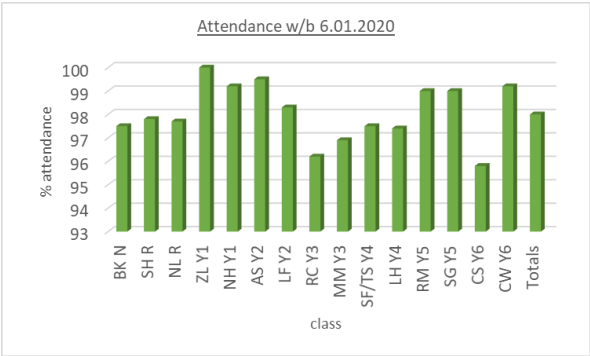
