Welcome back to school for another exciting year!

Our curriculum this academic year is:

In English, we will focus on developing a variety of skills through writing lessons and book studies, including grammar, punctuation and spelling. We will use Reading Plus to enhance comprehension and reading skills for those children ready to progress with this. Others will be completing their Little Wandle programme first. Additionally, our class novel will provide opportunities for shared reading and thoughtful discussions about the text.

In Maths, we will be following the National Curriculum as well as working on arithmetic skills every morning. We will be targeting aspects of maths that the children are less secure in, such as times tables, number bonds and place value. In Y4, pupils take part in a multiplication tables check (MTC). This is a statutory assessment which was introduced by the Government in 2022 for all Year 4 pupils in England. It is vital that children practise their times tables regularly at home. This will provide a strong foundation for the more advanced concepts that the children will encounter as they move further up the school.

Spellings

A copy of all spellings for the half term will be sent home. These spellings are based on the Year 3/4 National Curriculum list. Children will be tested every Friday in school using the Ed Shed app. They will have opportunities to practise their spellings in school and are also encouraged to continue learning at home. Each week, games are set on Ed Shed to make practising their spellings fun and interactive, these can be accessed at home using their log in details. In addition to the specific words, children will explore different spelling patterns to become even stronger spellers.

Homework

Homework will be given out on Tuesday each week to be handed in the following Monday. Inside the homework book, you'll find a grid with a variety of activities for children to choose from. Your child should complete one activity per week. We understand that there may be times when your child is unable to complete their homework. If this happens, please write a brief note in their homework book to let us know.

Further to this, we also ask that you continue to read regularly with your child and make any comments in their reading record. The fortnightly 'reading raffle' will continue through the year once again. To earn a raffle ticket, children must have their reading record signed at least four times by an adult during the week. One session at home on Reading Plus can be counted. Each class will then draw a winner during our celebration assembly, with the lucky reader choosing a book prize. As an extra incentive, those who receive a reading ticket will gain 15 minutes extra play at the end of the day on Friday. Those who have not, will gain an extra 15 minutes on Reading Plus.

P.E.

The children will be required to come to school in their PE kits on their various PE days, see below. PE kits include; white t-shirts/black shorts/tracksuit bottoms and school jumper and trainers.

Y3 Miss Snowden - Mondays
