Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)

- The MTC is a statutory assessment introduced by the Government in June 2022 for all Year 4 pupils in England
- Administered in schools at the start of June
- The check is completed on-screen
- 3 practice questions before taking the actual check
- Consists of 25 times table questions
- 6 seconds to answer each question
- 'Try it out' sessions
- To feel confident and fully prepared, we encourage children to know all their times tables up to 12×12 .
- Times Table Rock Stars can be used at home and the 'Sound Check' section of the app provides a simulation of what the official check will be like
